“ Aunt Cordelia was the youngest child of my grandparents, Duen (Duen-Ga, Sun-Joy) Hon and Kwai-Fong Yum. She was my only Aunt on my father's side. The 7 boys and a girl were the 25th generation of Hon-Kwong-Jorg-Tong where the family tree was held.

Aunt Cordelia graduated from the Kowloon True Light Middle School (She was the inspiration for me to choose that Chinese school in secondary education). She then get her career training as a nurse at the Alice Ho Miu Ling Nethersole Hospital on the Hong Kong Island, and later further certified in Sydney, Australia to work in the OR for heart surgery.

It was a blessing that she married Uncle Hei and had two brilliant boys in her family. The years after migration had placed us apart, but the feelings were always there whenever we had a chance to meet.

Unfortunately she was hit by a rare disease a few years ago. She had strong will and worked hard to regain mobility. It was heartbreaking to see her suffered when I saw her in the care facility in Sydney couple of years ago, and then, Uncle Hei passed away.

I am sure her surviving brothers will miss their only sister, I am missing an Aunt (we grew up like sisters), Patrick and Tobias are missing their dear mother, and her grandchildren are missing a loving grandmother.
