Mrs. Grace Mak 麥葛渝萍夫人 passed away peacefully on 25th April 2025.

Beloved Wife, Mother and Grandmother of Anthony Mak and Family.

Mrs. Grace Mak will be sadly missed and forever in our hearts.

A funeral service will be held on Friday 9th May at 10:30am, at St Peter's Presbyterian Church, North Sydney, preceded by a viewing at 10am.

The funeral will be followed by a burial service and wake at Macquarie Park Cemetery.

A donation box will be available on the day if anyone would like to make a donation. The proceeds will be donated to two causes: the Senior Citizens Group at Chinese Christian Church/ Crows Nest Centre, where Grace volunteered for over 25 years. Proceeds will also be donated to the Chinese Christian Bilingual Church. Grace has been a part of the Bilingual service first at CCC and then at St Peter's Presbyterian for over 35 years.

Parking at the church:

It was Grace's wish to have her funeral at St Peter's Presbyterian Church. Although parking is limited here on a week day, we her family sincerely thank you and are deeply grateful for your forbearance with this inconvenience, as it has enabled us to honour one of her last wishes.

Where possible, car-pooling or public transport is encouraged. The church is a 2 minute walk (130m) from North Sydney Train Station (please note, NOT Victoria Cross Metro Station).

If driving, please be prepared to drop-off those with decreased mobility. On weekdays, there are limited 1P parking spots across the street from the church on Blues Point Rd and also on Lavender St. Many of the spots nearby are 1/2P which may better suit those

with mobility parking passes.

We also encourage where possible, car-pooling to the burial. We sincerely hope you can join us for the Wake afterward for lunch and refreshments at 1pm as we gather to celebrate her life, and remember our Grace.

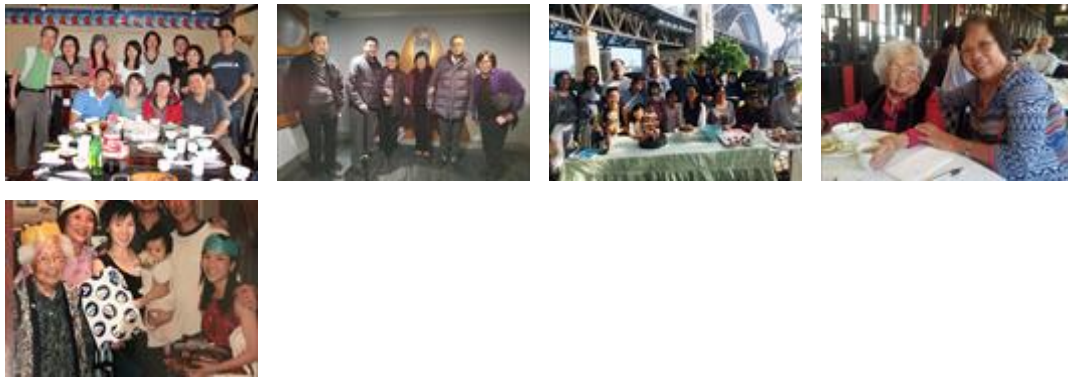
