Dr Cho was Board Director and Medical Director for Liverpool Division of General Practice from 1998 to 2008, then for Liverpool Medical Services from 2008 to 2020, and a pioneer of Liverpool GP After Hours Clinic. He lobbied to raise funds and established Liverpool GP After Hours Clinic which located in Liverpool Hospital has provided affordable and accessible GP type service in helping reduce pressure of Emergency Department, which was the busiest ED in NSW. He was also the Senior Lecturer for Western Sydney University. He has passion in delivery educational program to doctors and local communities. He organised many conferences either locally and internationally. He worked as a GP in Liverpool Local Government Area for more than half a century and provided his service to many people in the area.
