“ Ken and I have maybe known each other for six years. Six years in a life of 68, or for that matter a life of 56, is by no account a long period of time. He was a classmate in the Chinese calligraphy class, a classmate in the Cantonese opera singing class and, incidentally, a volunteering colleague on the Cherrybrook Chinese Community Association’s management committee. Chemistry or no chemistry, a lot happened in that period of time. Ken was an enigma, and I have been enigmatic on my part. Men all are. Men of our age, at this stage of life, don’t as a matter of course do little chit-chats as young lads do. Nor did we talk about our life or shared our distant dreams, not to mention the past ones. We didn’t talk about Tony Abbott or Barack Obama, or any politicians, unless they were on the news. Those things we reserved for our dinner partner, respectively, at our respective dinner table. As a matter of fact, I cannot recall when we talk what we usually talked about. Only that the time seemed to have passed rather effortlessly. Or if he had found the time boring, he didn’t tell. We did crack occasional jokes though, serious ones, teasing or pleasing each other or our own selves. All the same, we talked. We shared fun. We went through difficult times, did hard work or get through mundane routines together. He had been a part of my life.

Now, he’s left, almost suddenly. Such is life. I should not say I feel sad, however. Sadness is immeasurable. Sadness cannot be forgotten, nor can it be taken away. You cannot leave sadness alone, or just drop it by a shrug of shoulders. It is there, always, deep within the heart. But, we can transform it into energy, and gain strength from it, and live.

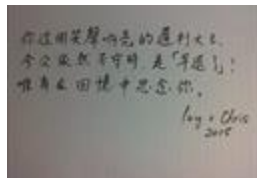
Betty was the MC in Autumn Rhymes, a concert held by Cherrybrook Chinese Community Association in May 2013, and Ken was the stage manager.

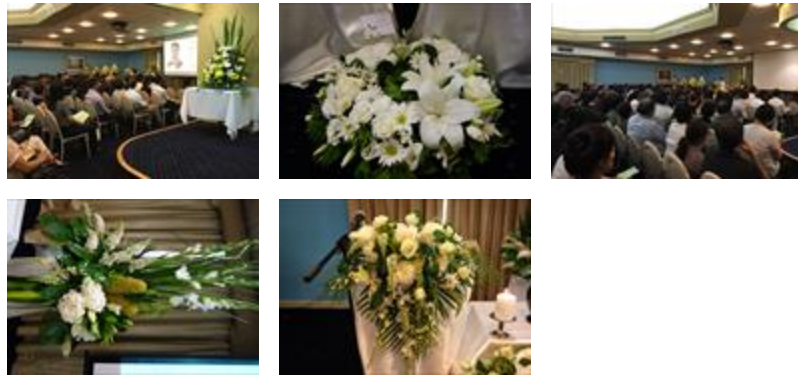
