“ Dearest Suemin

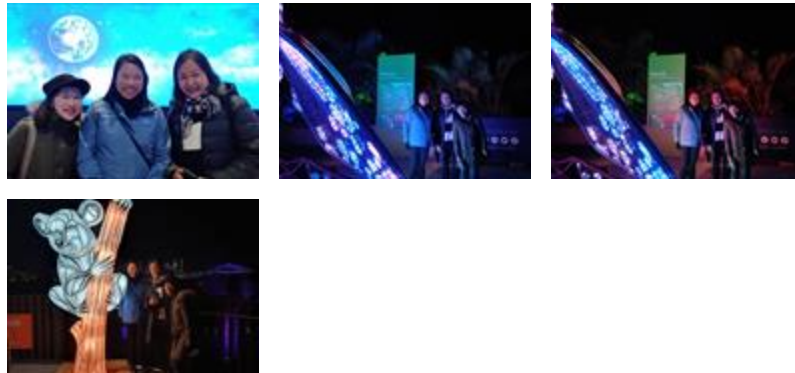
I was so glad that we reconnected after COVID lockdown. I only wish we reconnected earlier...
